As a preview to the Historic Knoxville City Tour, we will feature a guest speaker from the *East Tennessee History Center* which is dedicated to preserving and promoting the history of Tennessee, focusing on East Tennessee including well known figures who have contributed to the region’s reputation for hard work and independence, such as Davy Crockett, Nancy Ward, and Sgt. Alvin C. York.

May 16 We kick off this fascinating look at Knoxville’s rich culture and history with a tour of the *McClung Historical Collection* – one of the most comprehensive collections of genealogical data in the country. Each tour guest will receive a genealogy starter kit.

Then sit back and enjoy a driving tour of Knoxville with a knowledgeable step-on guide. We’ll view the *Old City*, historic churches, the *University of Tennessee Campus*; lunch at *Crescent Bend*, with a tour of the manicured formal Italian Gardens featuring nine fountains and a meticulously restored Civil War home. After lunch, we’ll visit *Blount Mansion*, home to William Blount, a signer of the US Constitution, US Senator, and first Governor of the Territory of the United States South of the River Ohio, and enjoy “Lemonade on the Lawn”. We’ll finish the day with a scenic cruise aboard the *Star of Knoxville Riverboat*, an authentic Mississippi style paddlewheeler.

This tour includes motorcoach transportation, tour guide, admission, lunch and all gratuities. The cost is U.S. \$67.00 per person.

May 17 With guide onboard, we will take you on a scenic drive to Vonore for a tour of *Sequoyah Birthplace Museum* – commemorating Sequoyah - father, soldier, silversmith, statesman, and creator of the Cherokee writing system. Never before, or since, in the history of the world has one man, not literate in any language, perfected a system for reading and writing a language. Then onto *Fort Loudoun State Park* – a 1200-acre site, one of the earliest British fortifications on the western frontier –where you will enjoy tranquil views of the Tennessee River, a special presentation of what life was like at the 18th century fort, and a picnic lunch. After lunch, we’ll tour the *Loudon Valley Winery*, a locally owned winery that produces more than seventeen varieties of wine from cabernet to mead; and *Sweetwater Valley Farm*, for a journey that takes you back in time to this era of fine farmstead cheese. The last stop before heading home will be at Fort Loudoun Dam, one of 29 hydroelectric dams managed by the Tennessee Valley Authority, which supplies power to more than 8.3 million residents in the TVA region.
