Problem Structures Workshop at University of Tennessee – Knoxville, May 30, 2008.

Oak Ridge National Laboratory and the University of Tennessee will host a Bruker-sponsored workshop on Friday, May 30, 2008. The morning session will include presentations by Peter Mueller (MIT), Victor Young (U. of Minnesota) and Charles Campana (Bruker AXS) on topics relating to the diagnosis of crystallographic problems and the advanced techniques which may be used for the successful solution and refinement of twins, disordered structures and incommensurate structures. The afternoon session will provide an opportunity for users to apply these methods to their own datasets.

This workshop will precede the Knoxville ACA meeting, but attendance and participation in the workshop is open to all Bruker users, whether or not they will register for the ACA meeting.
